

Pastor's Corner

Acts 5:27-32,40-41; Revelation 5:11-14; John 21:1-19

This Sunday's Gospel recounts the poignant episode where the Risen Jesus appears to seven of His disciples by the Sea of Tiberias. After a fruitless night of fishing, Jesus instructs them to cast their net on the right side of the boat, resulting in a miraculous catch. This event echoes their initial calling and serves as a powerful reminder of the abundance that comes from obedience to Christ.

Following the meal, Jesus engages Peter in a threefold dialogue, asking, "Do you love me?" This mirrors Peter's earlier threefold denial and signifies a moment of restoration and commissioning. Peter's affirmative responses lead Jesus to entrust him with the care of His flock, emphasizing the integral connection between love for Christ and service to others.

May this week inspire a deeper appreciation of the Risen Christ's presence in our lives and a renewed commitment to live out His love through service and obedience.


CATHOLIC EDUCATION WEEK 2025
