

## Process of Preparation to Celebrate Confirmation in 2026

The Sacrament of Confirmation is a significant step in the growth and development of every Catholic, necessary for the completion of baptismal grace. At Confirmation we affirm our commitment to God and the Church and receive a special outpouring of the Holy Spirit. The grace of this sacrament deepens our faith and brings us into a more abundant life with Christ, and strengthens us to share the love of Jesus Christ with others. It is by no means a "graduation" from practicing the faith, but rather just the beginning of a rich faith life!

### Receiving the Sacrament

Baptized children 11 years of age (grade 6) to 15 years of age are eligible to prepare for the sacrament of Confirmation. At Holy Name of Mary Parish the process for and the celebration of this sacrament is a family affair and involves both the parent and child.

"It is with great joy that we invite your family to our 'G.I.F.T.' preparation process for the sacrament of Confirmation. Confirmation is a time for young Catholics to acknowledge and deepen their commitment to their faith. Keeping this in mind, I want you to understand fully that the most important component of the preparation process is weekly attendance at Saturday/Sunday Mass

at Holy Name of Mary Parish. The expectation is that other than for serious reasons, Confirmation candidates and at least one adult family member, will be present each weekend for the celebration of Holy Mass at Holy Name of Mary Parish.

In the Mass, we encounter the Real Presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist. The Eucharist is the heart of the Church and weekly participation in Mass is a vital expression of Catholic faith and identity. At Holy Mass, we participate in the Church's life and receive the grace and strength we need to live as true disciples of Jesus Christ."
